



2019 CAP, Inc. (College Assistance Program) Grants | Application Guidelines

History

In 1977, the Miami-Dade County Public School System started a pilot advisory program with 10-12 part-time college assistance advisors. They were in the school system tasked with helping students find potential financial aid opportunities. The following year, CAP, Inc. was founded to financially support the Miami-Dade County Public School's College Assistance Program (CAP) and awarding scholarships to graduates that needed significant financial assistance to attend college.

CAP, Inc. provides scholarships to Miami-Dade County Public High School graduates who have exhausted all avenues of financial assistance (federal, state and institutional), but still have significant unmet needs to attend the college of their choice.

Deadline: Complete applications must be submitted online by Friday, May 24, 2019 at 4 p.m. No exceptions.

Eligibility

- Financial Need based on calculated "unmet need" to pay for college in the upcoming year
- Graduation from a Miami-Dade County Public High School or G.E.D. earned after November 1, 1996 with a minimum of two years in Miami-Dade County Public High School
- Accepted to/or enrolled in a post-secondary institution to pursue first undergraduate degree only
- **Full-time attendance** (12-18 credits) seeking a degree at a post-secondary institution
- **Must use the CAP grant only for the post-secondary institution named in the application**
- Complete application submitted online by the deadline. No information will be accepted by email, mail or fax. If an application is missing information or attachments, our offices will **NOT** inform the applicant.

Application Attachments + Special Instructions:

You will be required to upload copies of the documents below. **All required attachments must be uploaded as a single document in PDF or JPEG format.** For documents with multiple pages, you must combine them into a single document before they can be uploaded. PDF and JPEG are the only formats the online portal will allow.

1. **CAP Unmet Need Calculator:** Download this from the Foundation's website and complete it. Use the figures to enter into your application. And upload a PDF version of the document to submit online.
2. **FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR):** Upload all pages for the applied year. Applicants who are not eligible for US federal financial aid should completely fill out and submit a FAFSA worksheet.
3. **College Financial Aid Award Letter**
 - **Rising freshmen:** If you have not yet received your 2019-20 Financial Aid Award letter, contact your college or university's financial aid office to request the award letter. If your school is still unable to provide your 2019-20 Financial Aid Award letter by the CAP deadline, request an estimated award letter.
 - **Rising sophomores, juniors, and seniors:** If you have not yet received your 2019-20 Financial Aid Award letter, contact your college or university's financial aid office to request your award letter. If your school is still unable to provide your 2019-20 Financial Aid Award letter by the CAP deadline, you may submit last year's (2018-19) Award Letter.
4. **Unofficial College transcript if you are a returning for your sophomore, junior or senior year**
 - Required of all returning and new applicants starting their sophomore, junior, or senior year
 - Rising freshmen from Miami-Dade Public Schools do not need to their submit high school transcripts
5. **G.E.D. Diploma:** G.E.D. student applicants only

2019 CAP Grants Application (Continued)

Review + Awards Process:

- A completed application does not guarantee funding. It only guarantees review and consideration.
- **Awards are made for attendance at the educational institution you indicate in the application. Because they are based on unmet need for full-time enrollment at specific school, they are not transferable to another institution after grant is awarded. If an award is made and you transfer schools, or enroll less than full time, the award will be withdrawn.**
- Grants are not automatically renewed. You must apply each year.
- A committee will review and rate the applications and make final decisions on scholarship awards. Students will be notified of whether they have been selected to receive a scholarship via email by **Friday, July 5, 2019**.
- **We will use the email address you provide in your application to notify you.** So please be sure it is correct.

This is a template of the application that shows the information you will need to submit online. **Mailed, emailed or faxed applications will not be accepted.** Use this as a worksheet to gather the information you will need to provide online. To submit your application go to miamifoundation.org/scholarships and select this scholarship.

We recommend that you complete all questions that have character count limits in a word processing program first, paying careful attention to the character count limits - which include spaces - and then copy and paste your responses into the online application.

Awards are made for attendance at the educational institution you indicate in the application. Because they are based on unmet need for full-time enrollment at specific school, they are not transferable to another institution after grant is awarded. If an award is made and you transfer schools, or enroll less than full time, the award will be withdrawn.

1. **Cost of College:** Summarize anything unique about the cost of your education that might not be easily understood from the dollar figures you provided. Share any unique circumstance related to the "Unmet Need" cost gap you face to attend the college of your choice.
2. **Paying for College:** Summarize any challenging circumstances that impact you/your family's ability to pay for your college education. Circumstances might include: *recent death of a parent/guardian; parent/guardian lost employment since you submitted financial aid forms; family housing issues; expenses to care for a family member with special needs; you are a single parent attending college who is also the family's primary provider; you or your family must pay off debts for medical expenses, prior year's taxes, a bankruptcy, etc.*
3. **Remaining Unmet Need Gap:** Knowing that the CAP Grant award could range from \$500 to \$2,000 and now knowing your "Total Unmet Need," there may still be a gap in what you need to meet your financial obligations to fully pay for the college of your choice. If there is a gap, please share how you intend to cover this remaining financial gap. Your explanation may include additional sources of funding not included on the "unmet need" worksheet, or efforts that you will make to reduce your college costs.

Application Attachments

4. **Unofficial College transcript** - Upload if you are returning for your sophomore, junior or senior year
5. **G.E.D. Diploma** – Upload only if you are a G.E.D. student applicant
