History

The Epstein family established the Alan R. Epstein 'Reach for the Stars' Scholarship to honor the life of an outstanding young man who was tragically killed in an automobile accident. Scholarships are awarded to students who have overcome life's obstacles.

Submission + Deadline

Applications must be submitted online by **Saturday, April 30^h at 4 p.m.**

Applicants must submit an application via the Foundation's online grants application portal. To access the online portal, please visit the [Scholarships](#) page on our website and carefully review the registration instructions.

If an application is missing information, our office will not inform the applicant nor review the application. Mailed or faxed applications will not be accepted.

Eligibility

In order to qualify, applicants must:

- Be a high school senior graduating in May or June 2022
- Be accepted to a college or university and present a copy of the acceptance letter(s) with this application

Selection Criteria

A Scholarship Advisory Committee will review and rate the applications and make final decisions on scholarship awards. The following elements will be considered in evaluating applicants. Please review these guidelines carefully to see descriptions of each of these items:

- Alan R. Epstein 'Reach for the Stars' Scholarship Statement that describe circumstances related to your family's financial status
- Personal Statement Essay about personal obstacles and their positive impact on your life
- Volunteer/ Work Experience and School Activities
- Letter of Recommendation
- College Acceptance Letters
- Unofficial Transcript

Required attachments to be uploaded:

- **Personal Statement Essay:** Please submit a personal statement of no more than 2 typed pages describing circumstances that make you eligible for this scholarship such as obstacles or hardships that you have encountered and how you have dealt with them paying particular attention to how these experiences (disability, illness, failure, etc.) have made you more resilient.
- **Letter of Recommendation (1):** On letterhead stationery, please submit **one** letter of recommendation from a teacher/faculty member who has been involved in your high school education or from a member of the community whom you have worked with. Please include the nature and quality of the applicant's academic work, intellectual depth or breadth, character, and personal qualities. Do not send the letter separately. **You will need to upload the letter as a PDF document.**
- **College Acceptance Letter:** Upload the acceptance letter of the college or university you plan to attend.
- **Unofficial High School Transcript:** Please upload your transcript **as a single PDF**. Do not send the transcript separately.
